# About RMS Titanic: A Very Special Ship: Worksheet

Even before she sailed, the White Star liner was world famous

### Biggest? Most expensive? Fastest?

- With a length of 269 meters, RMS Titanic was the largest passenger ship in the world of its time. The biggest today is The Harmony of Sea (362 meters)
- ❖ It cost £7.5 million to build. (Around £400 million pounds at today's prices)
- \* RMS Titanic could accomodate 2,566 passengers. Only 1,317 sailed.
- ❖ There were 908 crew on board. 76% (696) would not survive.
- White Star marketed RMS Titanic as the 'largest and finest steamer in the world'.
- \* RMS Titanic was not an especially fast ship, even for her time.

# Safety Features

Several films falsely suggest that White Star sold tickets with the claim that the Titanic was 'unsinkable'. However, new safety features were a big selling point in marketing the ship.

- There were 15 watertight bulkhead compartments, each with watertight doors
- The new Marconi radio system enabled fast (SOS) distress calls.
- Titanic had more than the legal minimum number of lifeboats.

There was also a widespread belief that bigger ships safer. Few were concerned about the lifeboat passenger ratio. In the public mind, *RMS Titanic* was unsinkable.

### Fatal flaw in safety design

The most important design flaw was the height of the walls separating the bulkheads. These extended less than two metres above the water line. This meant that water could pour from one compartment into another if the ship pitched forward
