
Before Watching: Titanic Keywords Worksheet



Match the description to the the areas labelled on the ship The first one is done for you

- 1. The steam produced by the coal in the boiler rooms came out of the **funne**l (*A*)
- 2. The third class cabins were on the lower **decks** of the ship. (there were 14 decks)
- 3. First class cabins were on the upper decks, above the third class ones (E)
- 4. The lifeboats were on the top deck, near the bow (front of the ship)
- 5. The **bridge** was behind the **crow's nest** and near the bow.
- 6. Lookouts were in the crow's nest, half way up the mast. They watched for icebergs

This is *RMS Titanic* at Sothampton docks on April 10, 1912, shortly before it sailed.

Imagine you have taken this photograph. You are facing the bow (front) of the ship.

Write a postcard to a friend (25-50 words) Describe what you can see.

You could mention:

- The size of the ship (14 decks)
- The crew onboard the ship
- The people on the quay.
- The mast and the crow's nest.
- The funnels
