
Before Reading The Signalman by Charles Dickens



The signalman works down on a railway line beside a **tunnel**. To reach his **signal box**, he must climb down a path in **cutting**. From the signal box he can communicate by **telegraph** with other signal-men up and down the line.

If there is danger, the signalman warns the drivers of oncoming trains. He does this by walking onto the **track** carrying a red 'danger light'.
